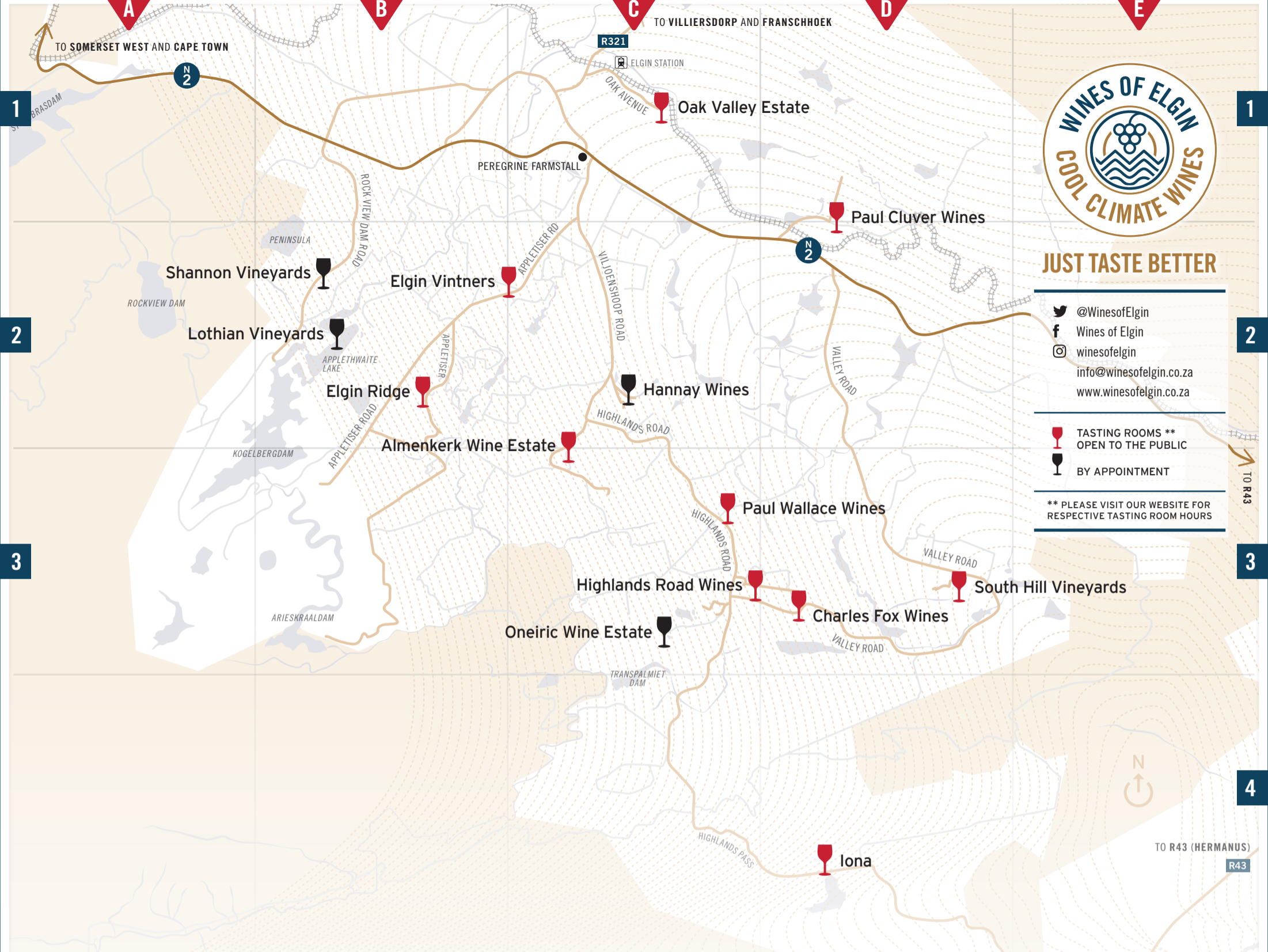

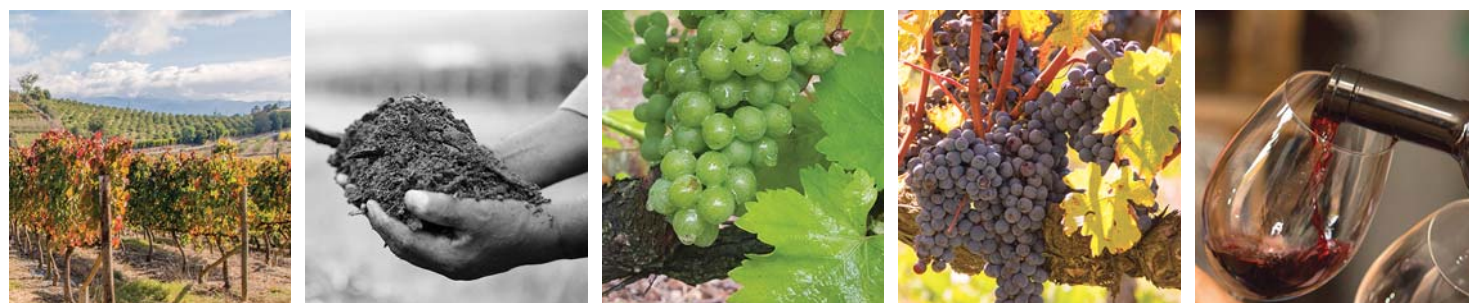
HISTORY Elgin is a highly acclaimed quality wine producing region situated 75km south east of Cape Town. Commercial wine production in the modern era started in 1985 with the establishment of experimental vineyards. Elgin was declared a wine ward in 1990 and has recently been proclaimed part of the Cape South Coast Region.

SOIL The soils are predominantly Bokkeveld Shale and to a lesser extent Table Mountain Sandstone, which is found on the circumference of the Elgin Valley. The Bokkeveld Shale consists of a reddish-brown iron-rich gravel with an underlying clay structure deposited on top of soft weathered porous shale. The Table Mountain Sandstone is visibly different. These light coloured quartzite soils formed some 400 million years ago when massive beds of sand in a marine delta environment hardened to become weather resistant sedimentary rock, somewhat acidic in nature.

CLIMATE The Elgin Valley enjoys a Mediterranean climate with an annual winter rainfall of between 800 and 1200 mm. Winter snow can often be spotted bedecking the peaks of the mountains that encircle our valley. In the summer the prevailing south-easterly maritime wind drapes our mountains in a grey shroud. This creates a cooling effect often accompanied by relatively high humidity or even a light touch of summer rain. Elgin's biggest advantage over other wine producing areas within the South African viticultural context is that our nights cool down. We enjoy a mean temperature of between 18°C and 19,5°C. The diurnal fluctuation allows the vines to resuscitate themselves and prolongs the grape maturation period allowing the slow and cumulative ripening of all the physiological elements of the grape.

VINES There are currently approximately 850 hectares under vine. The main varieties grown in Elgin are Sauvignon Blanc (40%), Pinot Noir (15%), Chardonnay (11%), and Shiraz (9%). Other varieties planted include Riesling, Viognier, Sémillon, Chenin Blanc, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Malbec. A feature of the terrain is a sequence of rolling hills with differing aspects and a range in altitude from 200 to 650 meters above sea level that presents a large variation of meso-climates. The Elgin Valley falls within the Kogelberg Biosphere, a Unesco heritage site at the core of the spectacular Cape Floral Kingdom. The Elgin producers take their environment seriously, aware that they are the custodians of the pristine mountain fynbos and as such are committed to sustainable viticulture. Most subscribe to the values encouraged by the Integrated Production of Wine system (IPW). Furthermore the Elgin Valley can boast a total of five Biodiversity Wine Initiative (BWI) Champions.

WINES Our "cool climate" ensures a long slow ripening of the grapes under ideal growing conditions. Sugar, acid, pH and flavour compounds harmonise to present wines which are distinguishable by their purity of fruit, complexity and elegance. The wines from the Elgin appellation are often characterised by a mineral core and underlying hint of spice.
