# WINE INDUSTRY COVID-19 PANDEMIC TIMELINE

Government issues the Amendment of Regulations of the Disaster Management Act

- No sales of any alcohol in the SA market within the 21-day period
- Production of alcohol for industrial use can continue
- Manufacturing of alcohol products ceases

The wine industry lodged an urgent application to government to allow farmers to complete harvesting.

Alert Level 3: Local market may trade (for the first time in 9 weeks)

- · Limiting the sale of alcohol to only off-trade
- Limiting the trading hours and days to Monday to Thursday, 09:00 to 17:00
- Online sales are allowed, but delivery must adhere to the specified time frame
- No on-consumption sales (restaurants and bars)

Alert Level 2: Local market may trade

- · Monday to Thursday, 09:00 to 17:00
- On-consumption seven days a week, adherence to curfew

## Alert Level 1 Hot Spot designation:

Local market, concession

 Registered wineries may sell wine and conduct wine tastings over weekends

Adjusted Alert level 3: Total ban on local sales

Government Gazette added the following to the list of essential services:

- "Harvesting and storage activities essential to prevent the wastage of primary agricultural goods"
- Agri-workers required to harvest grapes and/ or to operate as cellar workers, considered essential workers

Alert Level 4: Procure, package, transport and export of wine now allowed

- Permit the wine industry to do essential procurement, manufacturing (bottling, labelling and packaging) of wine under strict health and safety protocols
- Permit the transport of wine to port and airport for export and via road for export into neighbouring countries
- Permit essential support services such as inspection and certification

Alert Level 1: Local market, further concessions

- · Monday to Thursday, 10:00 to 18:00
- On-consumption seven days a week, adherence to curfew
- Registered wineries may continue to sell wine and conduct wine tastings, adherence to curfew



# WINE INDUSTRY CVID-19 PANDEMIC TIMELINE

## Re-adjusted Alert Level 3: Local market may trade

- · Monday to Thursday 10:00 to 18:00
- On-consumption seven days a week, 10:00 to 22:00 adherence to curfew
- Registered wineries may sell wine and conduct wine tastings during normal licenced hours

## Adjusted Alert Level 1: Local market additional restrictions

- Ban on local off-trade sales including tasting room wine sales for at-home use
- On-consumption permitted subject to adjusted curfew hours 23:00 to 04:00 and municipal bylaws
- Members of the public may transport
- Alcohol consumption in public places like parks, beaches etc. prohibited

### Adjusted Alert Level 3:

### Local market further concessions

- Local off-trade sales permitted Monday to Thursday 10:00 to 18:00
- · On-consumption seven days a week, 10:00 to 20:00
- · Registered wineries may sell wine and conduct wine tastings during normal licensed hours but no later than 20:00
- Transport of alcohol to ports for export, neighbouring countries and Africa permitted

26 JULY

## Alert Level 1

- Curfew 00:00 to 04:00
- On consumption until 23:00.
- Off consumption subject to normal license provisions but no alcohol may be sold after 23:00.

#### Alert Level 1: Local market normal trade

- Normal trading, except for trading during new curfew hours 24:00 to 04:00
- Alcohol consumption in public places like parks, beaches etc. prohibited

### Adjusted Alert Level 4: Local market complete ban

- No sale of alcohol for off-trade or on-consumption
- · Alcohol consumption in public places like parks, beaches etc. prohibited
- Transport of alcohol to ports for export, neighbouring countries and Africa permitted

### Adjusted Alert Level 2

- Curfew 23:00 to 04:00
- Off consumption Monday to Friday 10:00 to 18:00
- On consumption until 22:00
