### **- REGIONALITY SHOWCASING TERROIR**

Regionality and terroir are fundamental concepts in the world of wine, shaping the distinct characteristics and flavours of each bottle. Terroir encompasses the unique combination of soil, climate, topography, and even human intervention in a specific geographic area, influencing the grapes' growth and ultimately the wine's flavour profile. Understanding and appreciating regionality allows wine enthusiasts to connect deeply with the land and culture where the grapes are cultivated, fostering a sense of place in every sip. For example, the limestone soils of Robertson yield Chardonnay wines with crisp acidity and delicate minerality, while the granitic soils of Stellenbosch impart rich, intense flavours to its Cabernet Sauvignons. By recognizing the importance of regionality and terroir, consumers can explore a vast array of wines, each with its own story to tell, and develop a deeper appreciation for the artistry and craftsmanship behind every bottle. ### FRANSCHHOEK – CAP CLASSIQUE

Regarded as one of South Africa's leading Cap Classique-producing areas, the Franschhoek Wine Valley Cap Classique route is a first for South Africa. The abundant valley is renowned for producing outstanding Cap Classiques, from an impressive array of over twenty local producers ranging from large, traditional estates to more boutique, up-and-coming producers. Cap Classique is the South African term used to describe a sparkling wine made following the classic traditional method. Cap Classique wines range from those with 12 months' lees contact to rich, complex wines lying in the bottle for 60 months and more. Different styles such as Blanc de Blancs, blends and Rosé have emerged and range from dry to Demi Sec.

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## DURBANVILLE – SAUVIGNON BLANC

Cool-climate diversity and multi-generational know-how lies at the heart of Durbanville Wine Valley's world-renowned excellence across the spread of red and white wine styles. Among its renowned cultivars are category-leading Sauvignon Blanc, whose gentle nature comes to full expression in Cape Town's northern vineyards. Here, vineyards thrive under oceanic influence and farming that embraces the rhythm of nature since 1698, which lends itself to the production of crisp and racy Sauvignon Blancs that compete favourably on the international stage.

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### PAARL - CHENIN BLANC

The iconic granite outcrop, Paarl Mountain, guided early European settlers and gave the town its name. French Huguenots established viticulture in the region in the late 17th century. As one of South Africa's oldest wine-producing regions, Paarl prides itself on producing quality wines. The Paarl district has distinct terroir characteristics, including the wards of Voor-Paardeberg, Agter-Paarl and Simonsberg-Paarl. The soil, a mosaic of granite, shale and decomposed granite, imparts complexity to the wines. Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinotage, Chardonnay and Chenin Blanc thrive in Paarl's terroir. They produce wines that display ripe fruit flavours and refreshing acidity and have a distinct sense of place. Paarl stands as a testament to its rich winemaking heritage. Explore its diverse landscape and savour its rich terroirs.

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### ROBERTSON - CHARDONNAY

The Robertson Wine Valley lies 160km east of Cape Town and is characterised by cold winters and mild summers. With its limestone-rich soils, the result of marine fossils and ancient termite nests, Robertson is seen as a pioneer of South African Chardonnay, a variety proven to exude its finest nuances and balanced chemistry structure when grown on soils rich in chalk. Despite being situated 90km from the Indian Ocean, southerly breezes in summer bring a brisk coolness during the warmer months, adding to vineyard health and grape vitality. Robertson has South Africa's largest Chardonnay plantings which are vinified in a diverse selection of still wine styles, as well as used in the sparkling Cap Classique category.

Distinguished by its small, high-end production, the area is marked by visionary owners and family-operated estates. The Hemel-en-Aarde's exceptional terroir, characterised by ancient soils, benefits from its close proximity to the cold South Atlantic Ocean, resulting in a cool maritime climate ideal for producing extraordinary Pinot Noir. Wines of ethereal nature, making them a captivating choice for aficionados seeking intellectually styled, age-worthy red wines.
